THE VISION

To provide real-world interdisciplinary, personalized, and project-based learning experiences through a STEAM-based academic program where graduates become **the next generation of leaders, employers, and employees who contribute to the economic well-being of their communities and families.**

FUNDING THE GAP

\$2,000

Receiving only roughly 70% of scholar funding from state and federal departments, none of which comes from local property tax, **our deficit amounts to \$2,000 per scholar**.

\$1.5MM+

The **fundraising need for school year 2024-2025** amounts to over \$1.5MM.

\$40MM

With no government funding for transportation or facilities, LSC will have spent over \$15MM in equipment and facility expenses for its two campuses. To build out our future academy campuses in the next seven years, LSC will need to raise \$40MM.
